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NJASP'S SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST OF THE YEAR AWARD NOMINATION FORM 2008-2009

NJASP's School Psychologist of the Year Award is given to a NJASP member who is a practicing school psychologist in a public or private school setting. It is given in recognition of outstanding performance in the delivery of school psychological services. These areas include, but are not limited to, assessment, counseling, consultation, prevention, crisis intervention, collaboration, multicultural sensitivity, supervision, research, program planning and/or evaluation, etc. Candidates perform their jobs in an exemplary manner and have earned the respect of students, parents, teachers, school staff, administrators, and/or community members. Those who have benefited from this individual's efforts may include individual or groups of students, teachers, parents, administrators and/or the school system.

NOMINATION PROCEDURES

The Nominator must complete and/or obtain the following information:

- (1) Complete this Nomination Form.
- (2) Obtain a one to two page Candidate's Statement regarding current issues in school psychology and how they should be addressed.
- (3) Obtain the Candidate's resume.
- (4) The Nominator should complete a one to two page Nomination Statement indicating why this individual should receive this award.
- (5) Obtain one page Letters of Support from at least 3 but not more than 5 individuals who support this individual's candidacy for this award. Three letters should be from the members of the Candidate's school system (students, parents, teachers, school staff, administrators, etc.). Any additional letters can be from other individuals who are knowledgeable about the Candidate's abilities and skills.
- (6) Mail all nomination materials in one envelope postmarked by February 1, 2009 to: Terry Molony, NJASP Awards Coordinator, 21 Jefferson Drive, Laurel Springs, NJ 08021. Late applications will not be considered. Confirmation of receipt of nomination materials will be provided to the nominator.
- (7) NJASP's Awards Committee will review the applications and make a selection based on the materials received.
- (8) Award winners will be announced at NJASP's Spring Conference in May 1, 2009.
